This year Drigg Young Farmers are ‘pushing to new heights’ raising money for the Great North Air Ambulance. So far we have raised over £71,000 for the service with a Muck Haul, Beetle Drive, Mother’s Day Afternoon Tea, Race Night, Tractor Run, Auction Night, Local Shows, and of course the generous donations from members of the public, businesses and organisations. Our main event was Welly The Heli on 19th and 20th July, when we pushed and pulled a replica helicopter 77 miles from Drigg to the GNAAS Base at Langwathby, east of Penrith.
